Program / Role	Description	Commitment	Deadline to Apply
<b>Alumni Association Officer</b>	Alumni Associations provide opportunities for area-based members of Delta Sigma Phi to engage in professional, social, and philanthropic opportunities.	1-2 hours per week	Ongoing
<b>Alumni Chapter Officer</b>	Alumni Chapters provide alumni, from their chapter of initiation and/or affiliation, a space to engage with each other post-graduation. Officers are responsible for creating opportunities for professional, social, and philanthropic growth.	1-2 hours per week	Ongoing
<b>Alumni Corporation Board (ACB) Member</b>	ACBs provide business guidance to the chapter, which often includes advising on matters related to housing and scholarships. ACB membership is not limited to men or alumni of Delta Sigma Phi.	1-2 hours per week	Ongoing
<b>Chapter Advisors</b>	Chapter advisors advise undergraduate officers and communicate with the entire chapter as needed. Each advisory board has a Lead Advisor and advisors with specific focus areas that include: growth, health & safety, finance, campus experience, and membership experience.	1-4 hours per week	Ongoing

<p><b>LEAD Weekend Track Facilitator</b></p>	<p>Our two-day training program helps our newest elected officers learn how to improve operations in recruitment, health and safety, and membership experience. This year attendees will be in-person at three different campuses in November. Small group facilitators will lead participants in a specific track through a pre-written curriculum and activities, offering operational guidance and leadership support. <i>Travel, meals, lodging, and supplies are covered by the Fraternity.</i></p>	<p>November 2024; on-site role</p>	<p>9/1/2024</p>
<p><b>Leadership Institute Small Group Facilitator</b></p>	<p>Leadership Institute offers an immersive and physically active experience that teaches values-based leadership to a selected group of undergraduate participants. Facilitators guide small groups of participants through a pre-written curriculum and activities. <i>Travel, meals, lodging, and supplies are covered by the Fraternity.</i></p>	<p>July 2025; 5-day on-site facilitation</p>	<p>9/1/2024</p>
<p><b>Courage &amp; Culture Program Facilitator</b></p>	<p>Courage &amp; Culture Program Facilitators are trained to deliver prevention-related workshops to collegiate chapters relating to topics such as alcohol, hazing, and bystander intervention. Facilitators are expected to complete a minimum of two programs per semester. <i>Travel and additional expenses are covered by the Fraternity.</i></p>	<p>One-to-two workshops per semester</p>	<p>Ongoing</p>
<p><b>Foundation Scholarship Application Reviewer</b></p>	<p>Volunteers review scholarship applications submitted by undergraduate and alumni members. The review period is mid-March to mid-April.</p>	<p>3-5 total hours of application review</p>	<p>2/15/2025</p>
